1. Welcome to our District English Learner Advisory Committee Meeting- Mrs. Rogers called the meeting to order at 12:11pm. She welcomed Mrs. Viridiana Garcia, Mrs. Lorena Gutierrez (Interpreter), Mrs. Sandy Ramay (Principal), and Mrs. Kari Redfeairn and thanked them for attending a summer DELAC meeting.
2. Review the minutes from our previous DELAC meeting on May 23, 2016- Mrs. Rogers reviewed the minutes from the last meeting and asked the committee if there is anything that should be added or changed. Everyone agreed that the minutes were accurate.
3. Agenda Items:
 - a) Review and discuss the District's Title I Application- Mrs. Rogers explained to the group that the reason for this meeting is to review the Title I application and get input from the parents on the DELAC committee. She said that Lakeside is applying to receive Title I monies in order to offer more programs for the Title I students. Mrs. Ramay said that we are expecting to be eligible for Title I funds because 65% of our population district-wide is on the free & reduced lunch program. Because we have such a high population of students receiving free and reduced lunch, some of our students may need additional educational services. Some of our district committees such as Site Council, DELAC, and the LCAP committee will look at the testing data to discuss the needs of our students in order to improve learning. We have not received Title I monies in several years, but the district believes this would be best for our students because we would be able to provide more services for the students that need the extra support. She also shared that the district has purchased a new data program called Illuminate that will assist us in evaluating the data.
4. Comments/Questions/Advisement- Mrs. Garcia asked, "How many years back do you look at past scores?" Mrs. Ramay explained, "Since last year was the second year that we gave the CAASPP, we only have two years of data to look at."
