Dear LUSD families and staff:

The California Department of Public Health has updated its guidance regarding the management of student exposures to COVID-19. The new guidance, outlined below, takes effect on Wednesday, April 6, 2022. The Lakeside Union School District will be following this new guidance.

- Exposed, asymptomatic students, may now continue in-person instruction and all other aspects of K-12 schooling, including sports and extra-curricular activities, regardless of vaccination status or exposure location.

However, it is strongly recommended that exposed students:

1. Wear a well-fitting mask indoors around others for at least 10 days following the date of last exposure
2. Test 3-5 days following exposure
3. Monitor closely for symptoms

As COVID-19 conditions continue to improve, this guidance revision is designed to keep more students in classrooms and engaged in related activities, which are critical to their academic, mental, and physical wellbeing.

Thank you for your ongoing patience and support as we continue to navigate this consistently evolving pandemic together.
